2025-2026 Prediction from Lawrence Yun-Chief Economist & Senior VP of Research at NAR

### The Housing Forecast: 2025 and 2026

Because mortgage rates remain stagnant, NAR downgraded its housing forecast for the remainder of 2025—but upgraded its forecast for 2026 on the expectation that rates will begin to come down. Yun presented the following outlook for the housing market:

## **Existing-home sales:**

2025: +3%

2026: +14%

#### New home sales:

2025: +5%

2026: +5%

# Median home prices:

2025: +1%

2026: +4%

## Mortgage rates:

2025: 6.7%

2026: 6%

Jobs:

2025: +1.6 million

2026: +2 million



## TIPS FROM Houselogic during an Emergency

## What should be in an Emergency Survival Kit

Preparing and keeping a fully stocked home emergency preparedness kit could be the key to your family's safety if disaster strikes.

- Water: one gallon per person, per day (3-day supply for evacuation, 2-week supply for home)
- Food: nonperishable, easy-to-prepare items (3-day supply for evacuation, 2-week supply for home)
- Flashlight
- Battery-powered or hand-crank radio (NOAA Weather Radio, if possible)
- Extra batteries
- First aid kit
- Medications (7-day supply) and medical items
- Multi-purpose tool
- Sanitation and personal hygiene items
- Copies of personal documents (medication list and pertinent medical information, proof of address, deed/lease to home, passports, birth certificates, insurance policies)
- Cell phone with chargers
- Family and emergency contact information
- Extra cash
- Emergency blanket
- Maps of the area
